In “Informal Forms,” curated by Tel Aviv–based Noam Segal at Aran Cravey, includes a searing drawing by Karl Haendel of a guy in a hoodie with a white, blank sign around his neck and another drawing of two kids, one grinning with rifle in hand, with silhouettes of adults behind and the silhouette of what must be a prone deer in front.
